United States Probation and Pretrial Services Office Middle District of Tennessee Standard Conditions of Pretrial Supervision

- 1. The defendant must not violate federal, state, or local law while on release.
- 2. The defendant must cooperate in the collection of a DNA sample if it is authorized by 42 U.S.C. § 14135a.
- 3. The defendant must advise the court or the pretrial services office or supervising officer in writing before making any change of residence or telephone number.
- 4. The defendant must appear in court as required and, if convicted, must surrender as directed to serve a sentence that the court may impose.
- 5. The defendant must sign an Appearance Bond, if ordered.
