The 6-week construction-training program is for a Davidson County resident that has no open or pending charges against them and no previous record of sexual offenses, is in good physical condition and has, or will be able to obtain, a valid Drivers License and a dependable mode of transportation. Experienced instructors will help you learn various construction skills including: basic safety, introduction to power tools, introduction to blueprints and much more.

WHY PARTICIPATE: NCRP classes model a real job site. This provides you with valuable hands-on experience. Focusing on accountability, skills mastery and mathematics, you'll leave the program ready for entry-level work on any construction site with a certificate of the skills that you have earned.
